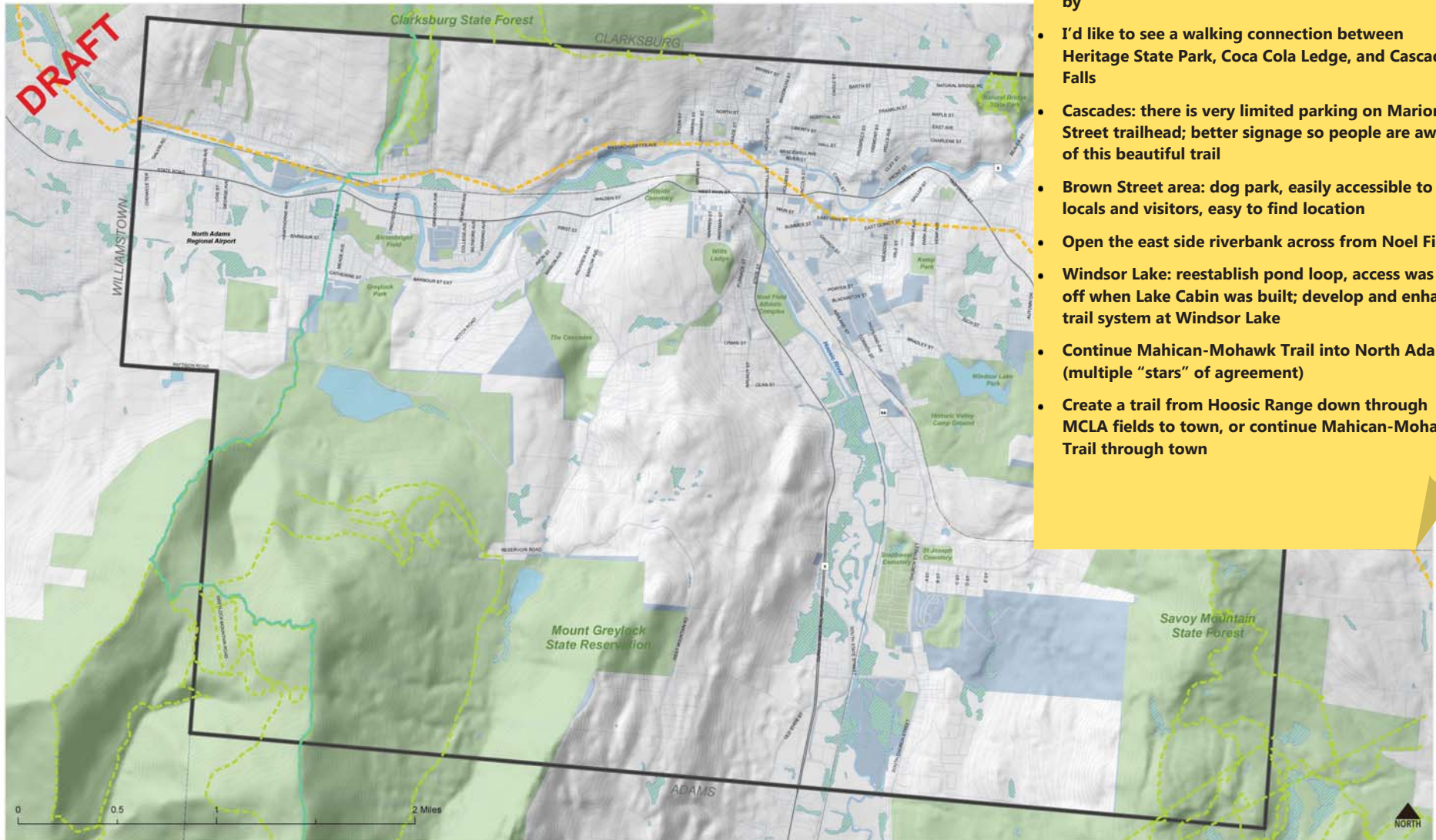


# TRAILS - IMPROVING DIRECT ACCESS

Comments Received 02/28/2013:

- Brown Street music shed, River and trail going right by
- I'd like to see a walking connection between Heritage State Park, Coca Cola Ledge, and Cascade Falls
- Cascades: there is very limited parking on Marion Street trailhead; better signage so people are aware of this beautiful trail
- Brown Street area: dog park, easily accessible to locals and visitors, easy to find location
- Open the east side riverbank across from Noel Field
- Windsor Lake: reestablish pond loop, access was cut off when Lake Cabin was built; develop and enhance trail system at Windsor Lake
- Continue Mahican-Mohawk Trail into North Adams (multiple "stars" of agreement)
- Create a trail from Hoosic Range down through MCLA fields to town, or continue Mahican-Mohawk Trail through town
